- Establishing clear policies and guidelines for volunteering.
- Risk mitigation, safety and hygiene requirements.
- Check insurance coverage of your employees while they are volunteering.
- Promoting the program to employees through effective communication.
- Measurement and evaluation of program effectiveness.
- Recognising and rewarding employee participation.
- Ensuring long-term sustainability and commitment to the program.
